Program Overview

Program Goals

- Develop leaders in emergency medicine
- Provide advocacy training to promote emergency medicine
- Prepare program graduates for leadership positions
- Encourage relationship-building, networking and mentorship

Who Should Apply?

- Applicant must be a current member in good standing with Ohio ACEP and be board-certified or board-eligible in EM, ideally in the first eight years of practice.
- Applicant must have a minimum of two years membership in ACEP or EMRA.
- Applicant must agree to attend all scheduled sessions.

What is Needed to Apply?

- A complete application which includes background and contact information, leadership experience in organized medicine or the community and a statement of interest.
- A letter of reference that speaks to the applicant's leadership performance or potential and commitment to continued development.
- A current CV

Fees and Expenses

- Cost of participation will be shared by the participant and Ohio ACEP.
- Ohio ACEP will cover program costs, applicable registration fees, program materials and networking events.
- Physician participants will be responsible for hotel accommodations, meals, and travel to/from sessions including ACEP Leadership & Development (Washington DC), ACEP Council (Chicago, IL) and program and Chapter events (Columbus, Ohio).

Participant Selection/Applications Due: April 23

- The Leadership Development Academy Task Force will select participants based on completed nomination forms submitted by April 23, 2026.
- Selected participants will be notified in early May.
- Nominees who are not selected for the 2026-2027 class may reapply the following cycle.
